



MIT Committee on Prehealth Advising (COPA) Timeline	
September – December 12, 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Schedule a <b>2019 COPA Enrollment Appointment</b> through CareerBridge (strongly recommended if you haven't met with a Prehealth Advisor in the last 6 months)</li> </ul>
November 28 – December 12, 2017 5pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Request a COPA letter*</li> <li>Pay your Prehealth Credential Service Fee</li> <li>Create a Prehealth Credential Service Account**</li> </ul>
January 22, 2018	<p>Upload all required materials to your Credential Service account:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Transcript(s)</li> <li>✓ Resume</li> <li>✓ Personal statement draft</li> <li>✓ Prehealth Advising Questionnaire responses</li> </ul>
January 30 – February 2, 2018	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Reserve an interview time with a COPA faculty member and the Associate Director of Prehealth Advising You will be emailed the online scheduling tool.</li> </ul>
February 20 – May 1, 2018	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each student will be interviewed by a COPA faculty member and the Associate Director of Prehealth Advising for approximately 30-45 minutes</li> </ul>
April 13, 2018	<p>ALUMS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Submit your Prehealth Credential Service account, including letters of recommendation, by this date</li> </ul>
May 31, 2018	<p>UNDERGRADS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Submit your Prehealth Credential Service account, including letters of recommendation, by this date</li> </ul>

\* The Committee on Prehealth Advising (COPA) Letter is sent as a part of your committee packet that includes your individual recommendation letters. It includes information on your academics, research experience, clinical experience, and extracurricular/service activities. **The annual, non-refundable \$100 Prehealth Credential Service Fee** is required at the time you submit the COPA letter request form.

\*\* When you request the COPA letter, you will be prompted to open a **Prehealth Credential Service Account**. The Prehealth Credential Service Account is where you will request letters of recommendation and upload your resume, personal statement, transcripts, Prehealth questionnaire responses, etc.



<b>Medical School Application Timeline</b>	
<b>May 2018</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fill out your AMCAS* application (Applications open the first week of May)</li> </ul>
<b>June 2018</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Submit primary application (AMCAS, AACOMAS, AADSAS)* (Applications can be submitted starting the first week of June)</li> </ul>
<b>June 30, 2018</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Submit primary application by this date (strongly recommended for MIT applicants)</li> </ul>
<b>June – August 2018</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Return secondary application within 2 -3 weeks of receipt (Interested schools will send you secondary applications)</li> </ul>
<b>September 2018 – April 2019</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You will be invited to medical school interviews (Schedule a <b>mock interview</b> with a Prehealth Advisor)</li> </ul>
<b>October 15 2018 – Summer 2019</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Medical schools send acceptance, rejection, waitlist letters (You may hold multiple acceptances until April)</li> </ul>
<b>April 30, 2019</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Confirm with one school and withdraw all other acceptances</li> </ul>
