^{**} When you request the COPA letter, you will be prompted to open a **Prehealth Credential Service** Account. The Prehealth Credential Service Account is where you will request letters of recommendation and upload your resume, personal statement, transcripts, Prehealth questionnaire responses, etc.

May 2018	Fill out your AMCAS* application (Applications open the first week of May)
June 2018	Submit primary application (AMCAS, AACOMAS, AADSAS)* (Applications can be submitted starting the first week of June)
June 30, 2018	Submit primary application by this date (strongly recommended for MIT applicants)
June – August 2018	Return secondary application within 2 -3 weeks of receipt (Interested schools will send you secondary applications)
September 2018 – April 2019	You will be invited to medical school interviews (Schedule a mock interview with a Prehealth Advisor)
October 15 2018 – Summer 2019	Medical schools send acceptance, rejection, waitlist letters (You may hold multiple acceptances until April)
April 30, 2019	Confirm with one school and withdraw all other acceptances
